RULES AND GUIDELINES

Participant commitment includes Saturday morning set-up between 6:30 and 8:30 a.m. Tear down will be allowed beginning at 4:00 p.m. NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS PRIOR TO 6:30 AM and must be parked off site between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

All participants shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and requirements and shall be solely responsible for the payment of any taxes imposed by any lawful jurisdiction as a result of the activities of this event.

RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1. ***Participants are purchasing booth space only – Each participant must provide their own booth. Food booths must bring a fire extinguisher to be kept in their booth.**
2. Booths shall be free standing, no ground stakes will be allowed.
3. Participants shall present themselves in a reasonable and non-offensive manner.
4. If participant has a structure to erect, they must ensure at all times that such structure shall not obstruct walkways.
5. Should participant at any time occupy the premises in a manner contrary to this agreement, upon request of the staff, participant shall immediately cease offending conduct. Failure to immediately comply as requested shall be cause for revocation of this permit and expulsion from this event.
6. Application will be juried as to assure conformity with the event mission and objectives.
7. **There will be no electricity available.**
8. ***Food Vendors are responsible for obtaining their own temporary food vendor licenses in compliance with the Pierce County Health Department regulations.**

APPLICATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE

Participant has read and understands the rules and guidelines for the 2008 “Cirque City-wide Summer Garage Sale” and is bound by the terms and conditions outlined in the guidelines.
